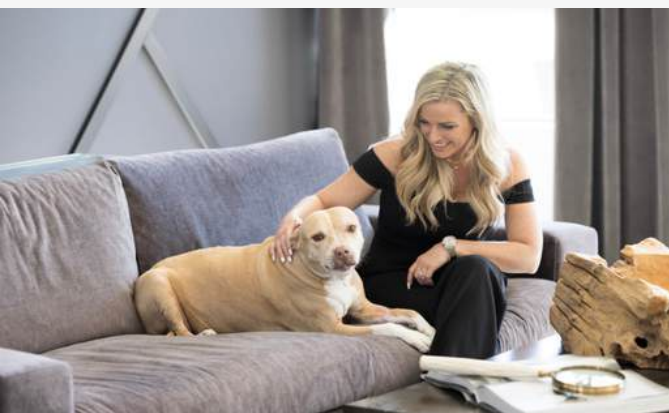
Today, that mission continues to save lives and provide hope and healing to the neglected, giving them a second chance at life and love.

stay connected to nature.

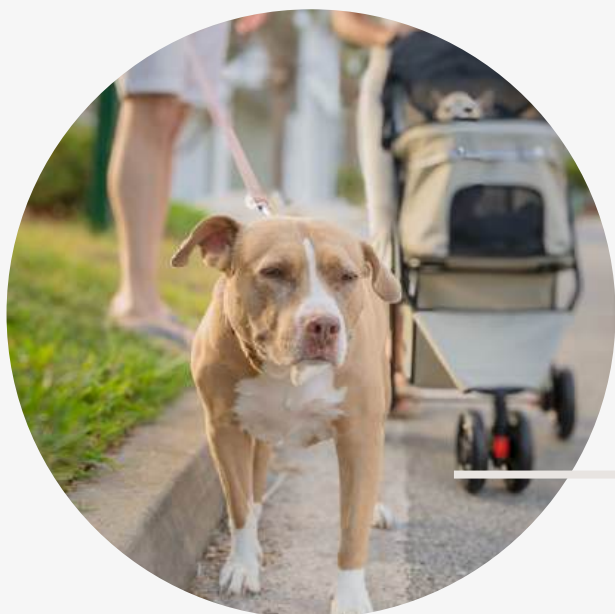

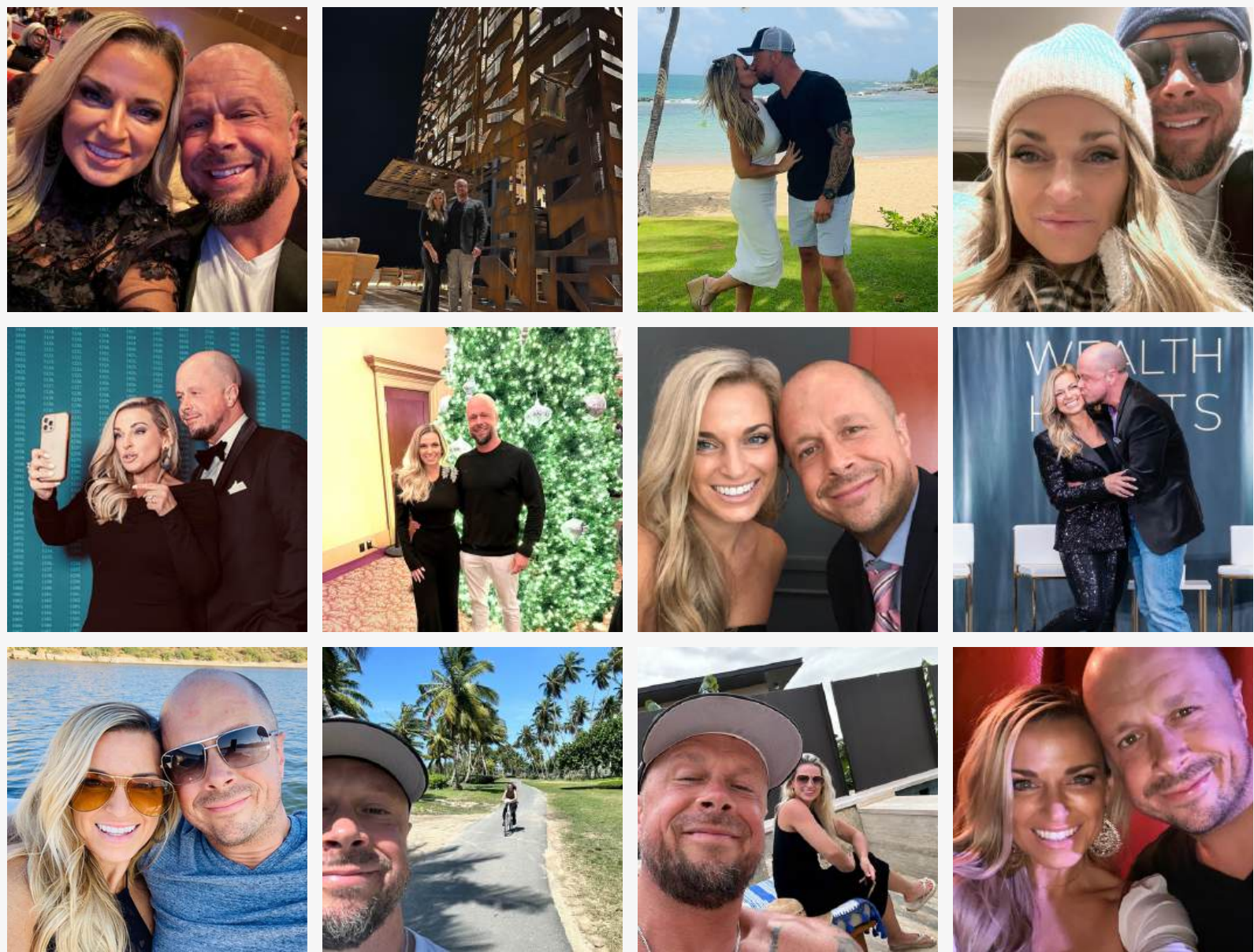


ANTHONY'S FAMILY
