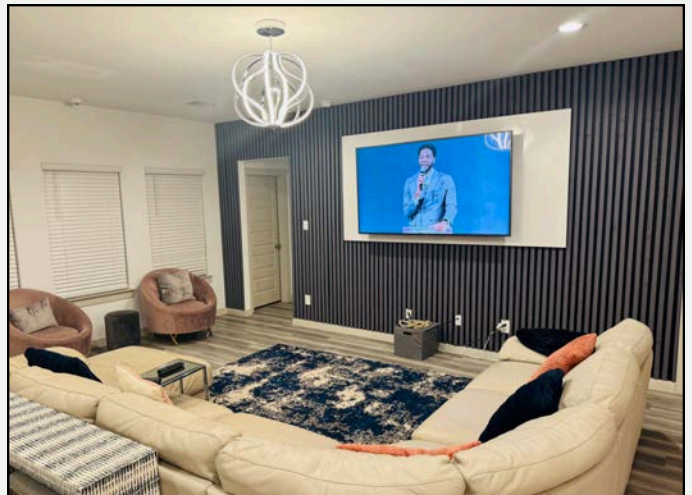
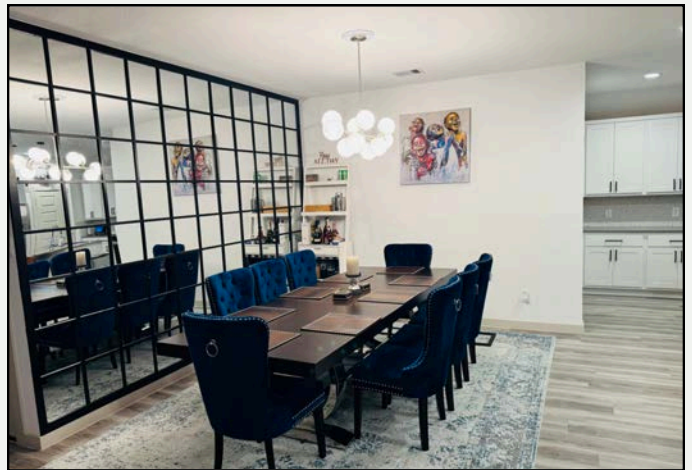
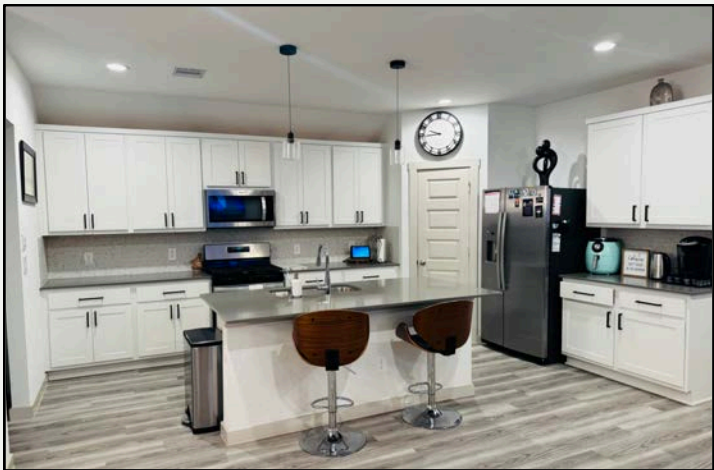

There are many families with children who live in my community and there are always planned activities for kids. My nieces and nephews always love to go to there when they visit.





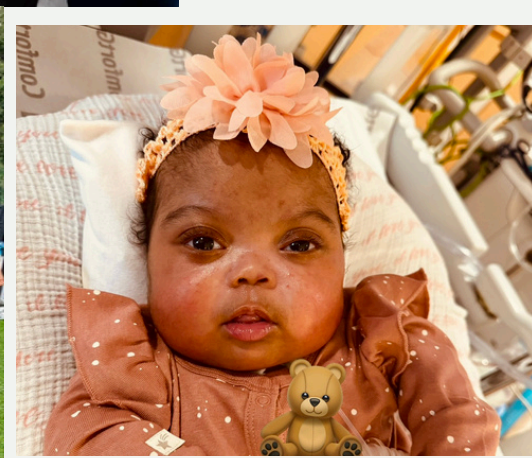
School District

My culture

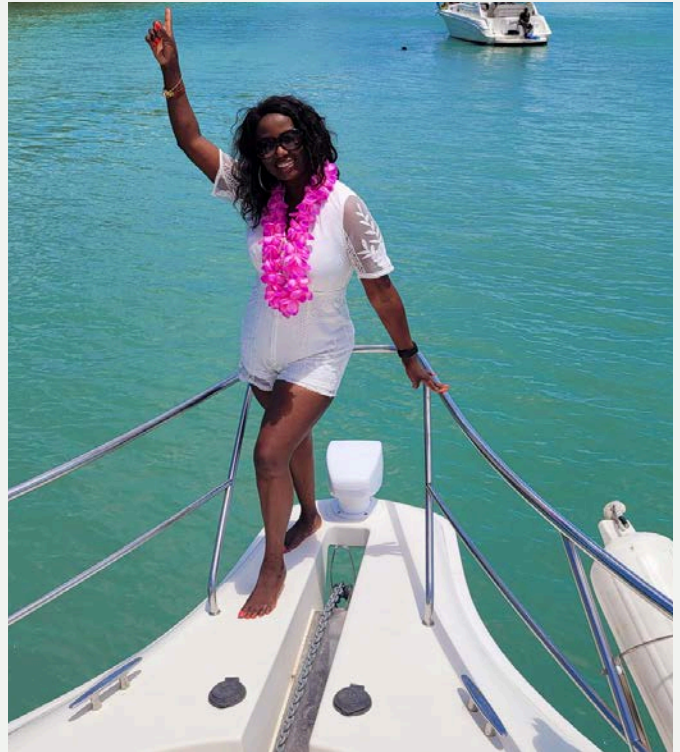
