We admire the strength and selflessness in the decision you are considering. We recognize that

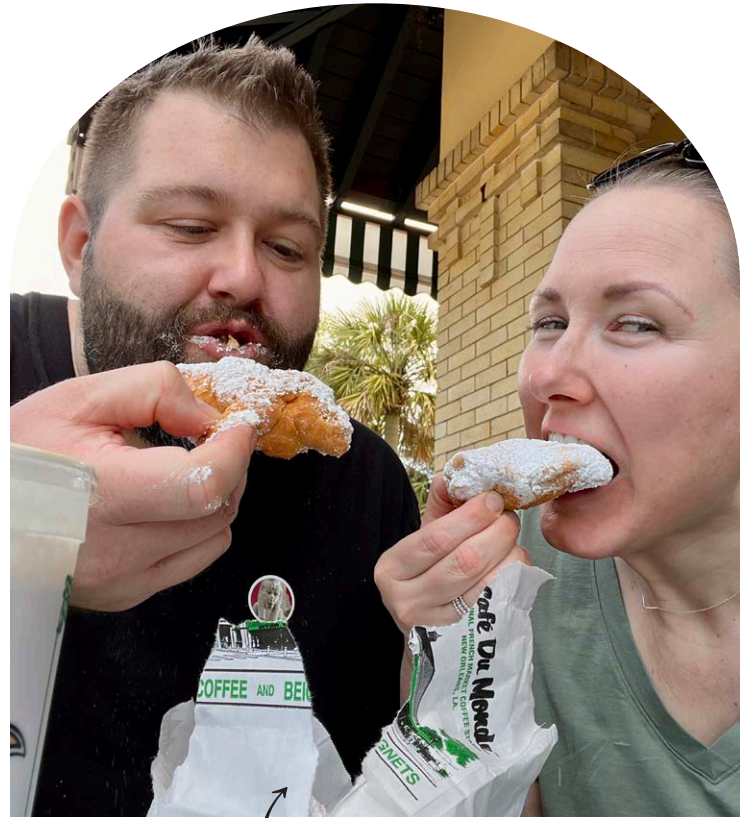

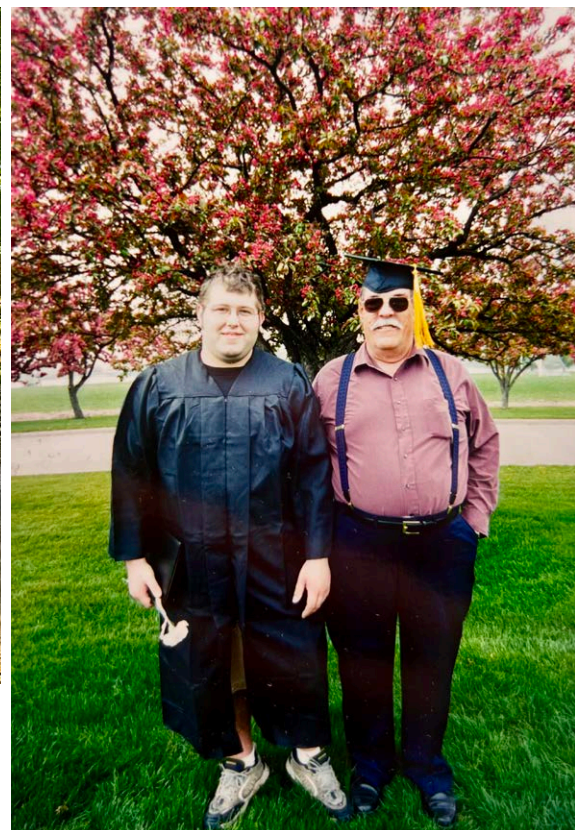


meet our FAMILIES

TOGETHER

The community we live in rallies around its people. A great example is the annual “Barney Fun Run,” held in honor of Rachel’s uncle, who suffered a traumatic brain injury 50 years ago. Ever since, he’s faithfully run the same route through town as a way to care for his mental health and keep his positive outlook on life. His motto is, “Another beautiful day!” Participants walk/run his route to raise money for a local person in need. The fun run is a day filled with gratitude, good energy, and a sense of togetherness—something the community looks forward to every year. When we think about becoming a parents, we hope to share experiences like this with our child, so they grow up surrounded not only by family traditions, but also by a community that values kindness, resilience, and lifting one another up.

My favorite childhood memories are from family road trips my dad would plan. He worked hard, but he always made time for summer adventures—whether it was camping, spending the day at a waterpark, or packing all five of us into a van for a trip to the Rocky Mountains—that’s where my love of road trips began. At sixteen, I got to take the early morning driving shift, watching the sunrise over new landscapes while my family slept. When I think about becoming a father, I want my child to experience that same sense of wonder I felt peering out the car window at the open road ahead, to feel the excitement of exploring new places and the comfort of knowing they’re surrounded by love wherever we go.

My family's Christmas traditions are some I hold dearest. I grew up working at my family's business—a supper club that includes a restaurant and bowling alley. Every Christmas Eve the business closes its doors and our extended family gathers there together. The interior sparkles with warm Christmas lights and holiday décor. When I think about becoming a parent, I hope to create holiday traditions like this that make the season feel magical for my child.

I've never been much of a breakfast eater, but I was on those mornings—because he loved breakfast and I loved the one-on-one time with him. My dad passed away unexpectedly in July 2025 following a short illness. The undivided attention and uninterrupted conversations we shared during those breakfasts are memories I deeply treasure now. I look forward to giving my child that same kind of attention—simple, intentional moments where they know they are seen, heard, and loved.
