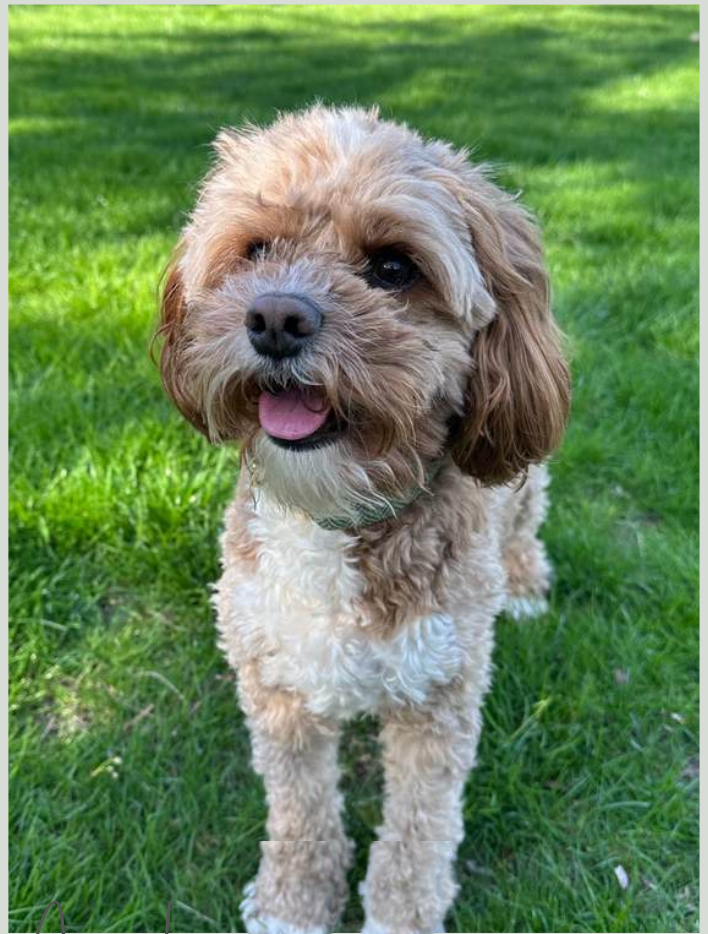


MEET OUR PETS

Our 3-year old Cavapoo, Archie, is a bundle of energy. We adopted him shortly after getting married, and he's grown into a loyal, snuggly pup.

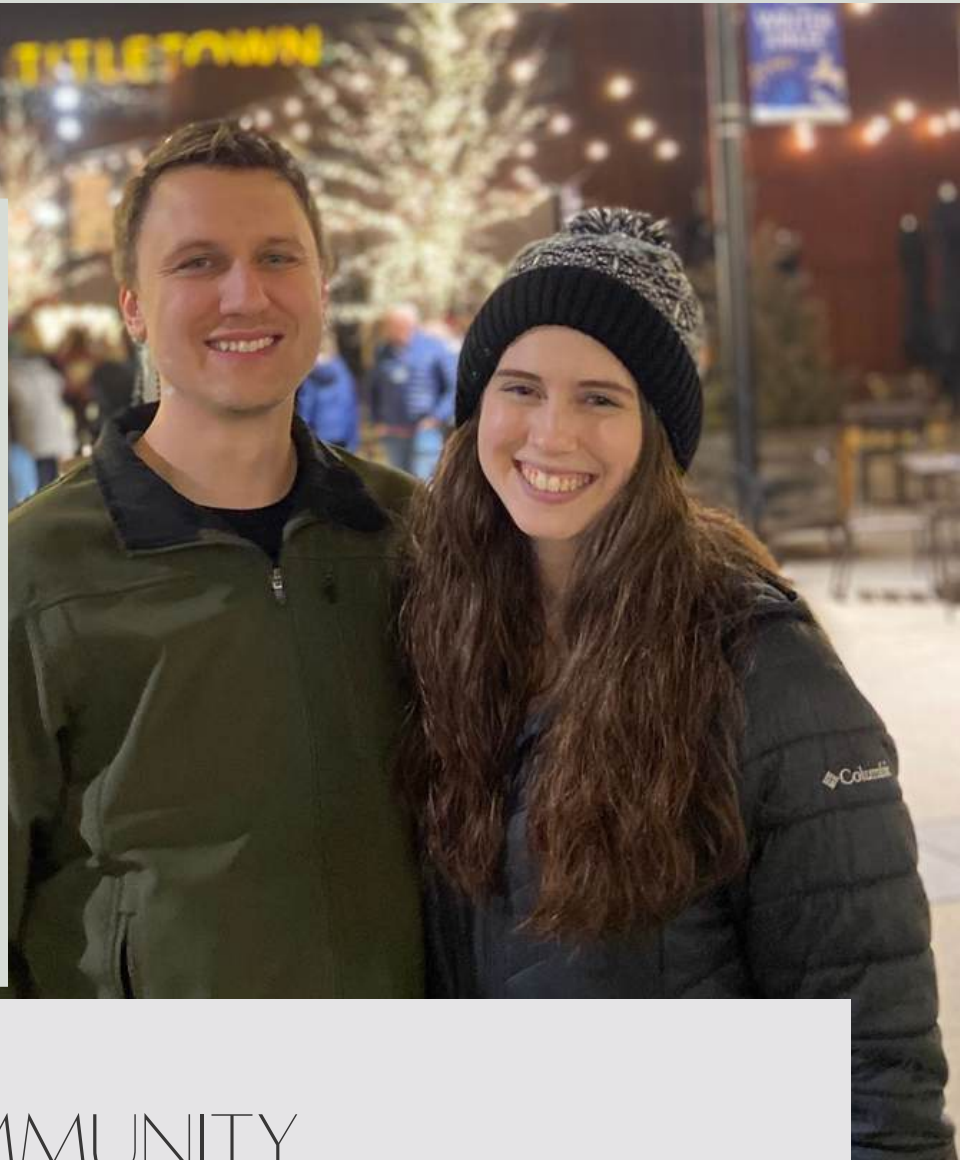

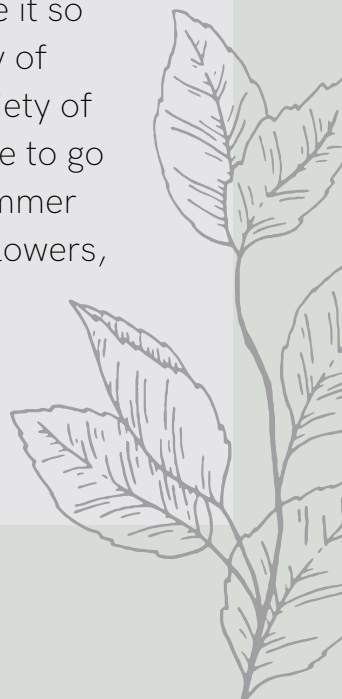
