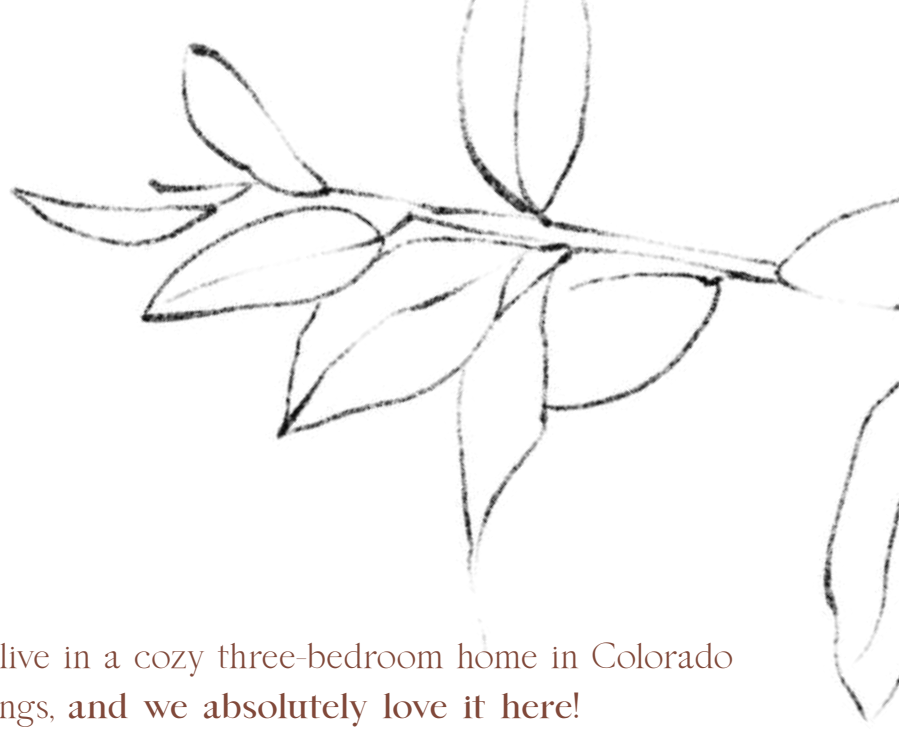
Titus - 3 years old

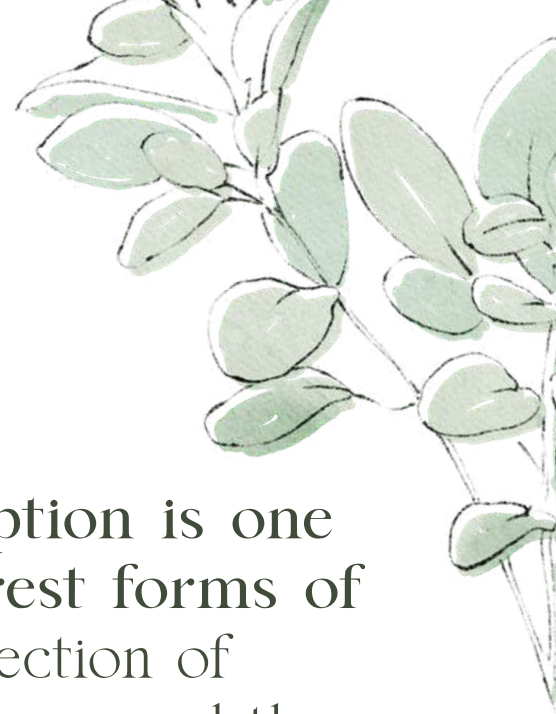
